Abstract:	This paper aims to share experiences in understanding, exploring and creating landscape space in studio projects. Catherine Dee's book, "Fabric and Form in Landscape Architecture: A Visual Introduction", has, over the years, been a valuable source of mainly a visual approach toward conceiving the nature of landscape space and multitude ways to create successful landscape projects while teaching landscape design studio courses.
